



## *Owd Betts Pub and Restaurant*

*Richard and Mary Ashworth*

*Built 'Owd Betts' in 1796*

*Richard and Elizabeth Ashworth*

*Son of Richard and Mary who married and took over the running of 'Owd Betts'  
Known at the time as The Hare and Hounds Inn*

*John and Betty Ashworth (Owd Bett)*

*Son of Richard and Elizabeth who married Betty Ramsbottom in 1839  
They took over the running of the Hare and Hounds mid 1800's  
John died aged 49 in 1866 and Betty continued to run the inn until the mid 1880's*

*Robert Roberts and Alice Ashworth*

*Betty's daughter Alice married Robert Roberts in 1875  
They took over the running of the pub mid 1880's after Betty had retired.  
They ran the pub for 28 years.*

*John Ashworth Roberts*

*Son of Robert and Alice. He took over the running of the pub after his mother and father  
retired and continued to run it until 1922*
